Gentlemen of the Press, it is with gratitude to Almighty God that I address you this day on the occasion of the combined Sixth and Seventh Convocation ceremony of the Federal University Lokoja, which incidentally is the second ceremony since my assumption of office as the Vice-Chancellor of this University.

#### **Relocation to the Permanent site in Felele**

I want to inform you with utmost excitement that all the programmes of the University are now domiciled on the Permanent Site in Felele. The Faculties of Arts, Education, Engineering, Management Sciences, Science, Social Sciences have been relocated to the Felele Campus and all academic activities now take place here on the Campus. While the Take-off Campus in Adankolo now houses the College of Health Sciences and the Department of Nursing Science.

#### **Establishment of new Academic Programmes**

On my assumption of office as Vice-Chancellor of Federal University Lokoja (FUL), I came with, amongst other visions, the agenda to establish some academic programmes that were not in existence in FUL but are of high demand by the citizenry of this State.

I am glad to inform you that the University today added to its academic programmes, Medicine, Nursing and Engineering while Agriculture, Law, Pharmacy, Psychology and Medical Laboratory Sciences programmes are in the pipeline.

# Admission into newly established Academic Programmes of Federal University Lokoja

It is no longer news that our College of Health Sciences has taken off fully with our pioneer students now in the 200 Level. I am however, happy to inform you that the maiden students' admission exercise into the Engineering and Nursing Programmes will take place in the 2023/2024 academic session.

I want to use this occasion to express appreciation to the Federal Government under the immediate past President His Excellency, Muhammadu Buhari for the approval to convert the Federal Medical Centre Lokoja to Federal Teaching Hospital to be used as Teaching Hospital for our Medical programmes.

We are using this medium to appeal to the good people of the State to help us develop the Teaching Hospital by providing Auditorium, Lecture Theatre, and Hostels.

#### 2023 Sub-Sahara African Varsities' Ranking

It is my delight to report that Federal University Lokoja falls within the 51<sup>st</sup> - 60<sup>th</sup> bracket out of the 120 Sub-Saharan Universities that were ranked on 26<sup>th</sup> June, 2023 by the Times Higher Education.

The University was in the 17<sup>th</sup> position of the 51 Nigerian Universities ranked and 9<sup>th</sup> position amongst the Federal Universities. This was disclosed by Professor Peter Okebukola, the Chairman of Nigerian Universities Ranking Advisory Committee on his return from Accra, Ghana where the exercise took place.

#### **International Relations**

The University is trying to penetrate Cuba through the Ambassador for the development of our Medical and Engineering programmes. Already we are relating to the University of Freiburg in Germany and Morgan State University in the United States of America (USA).

#### **Inaugural Lecture**

Two Inaugural lectures were held before I assumed office in 2021. Today, a total of fifteen (15) Inaugural Lectures have taken place. It is a University culture and a way of showcasing our academic achievements.

#### **Community Service**

This Administration has established both Primary and International Secondary Schools where quality education is made available to the community. The schools have continued to attract patronage from the length and breadth of both the University community, Lokoja and its environs. The University has also established some Diploma programmes to prepare our young ones who have not been able to proceed directly for degree programmes due to their inability to meet admission requirements.

Pre-degree programmes have also been established in some selected areas in the State.

#### **Consultancy Services and Ventures**

The University established a Consultancy service and Ventures Directorate christened the FUL Felele Consult Ltd which has been the driving force of its efforts at generating revenue. Some of the ventures undertaken include the FUL Printing Press, the Water Factory and the Block making Industry. The revenue generated from these ventures have assisted the University to meet some of its urgent needs that are not catered for by Government subventions.

#### **Infrastructural Development**

I also wish to report to this medium that in spite of the dwindling funding of public Universities and the paucity of funds available for the use of the University, I am glad to announce that the following infrastructural developments have been accomplished by the University most of which were obtained through personal efforts of the Vice-Chancellor and his team:

- a. Construction of road networks linking the main Gate to the Administrative Block, Students Hostel and University Farms, ring roads connecting the Senate Chamber through the professorial offices block, administrative block through Faculty of Science to the Library.
- b. Construction of Entrepreneurship Centre where all our students are now trained in one skill or the other after which they will be registered with Corporate Affairs Commission and certificated.
- c. Construction of 12 blocks of Lecture Halls
- d. Construction of University Mini-Stadium and Recreational Centre.
- e. Expansion of the University Health Centre The Health Centre is now opened to the public for consultation and medical attention.
- f. Solar powered electrification of the streets/road networks on the Campus.
- g. Construction of 40 blocks of Shops on Build, Operate and Transfer model
- h. Renovation of Faculty of Science Complex
- i. Renovation of the University Library and ICT Centre
- j. Construction of Agricultural Training Centre facilitated by the Federal Ministry of Agriculture
- k. Connection of electricity from the Lokoja Power Substation to link the University to the national grid.
- 1. Procurement of a fire fighting service Truck
- m. Construction of Security building

- n. Renovation of the Male and Female Hostels at the Adankolo Campus for the MB;BS students.
- o. The construction of 4-Storey Senate Building in progress.
- p. The construction of the Faculty of Engineering in progress
- q. Two 18-Seater Buses donated by Dr. Innocent Ozoemena Ezuma which is highly appreciated by the University.
- r. Grant of N250,000,000.00 from BUA Cement for the construction of our Central Laboratory for which the University deeply appreciates.

#### **Distinguished Personality Public Lecture**

In our bid to continue to foster the Town and Gown relationship and also to ensure that the University's culture and tradition of academic excellence subsist in FUL, the 4<sup>th</sup> in the series of our distinguished personality Lecture took place on Wednesday, 11<sup>th</sup> October, 2023.

The University played host to His Excellency, Professor Ibrahim Agboola Gambari CFR, the Chief of Staff to the immediate past President of the Federal Republic of Nigeria. He delivered the Distinguished Personality Public Lecture titled "The relevance of University Education in Innovation for the advancement of Town and Gown Symbiosis". The erudity of his presentation was as refreshing as it was rewarding.

#### Federal University Lokoja Endowment Fund Launch

The Federal University Lokoja during this Convocation ceremony will be launching an endowment fund. The University is through this medium soliciting the support and contributions of all well meaning Nigerians to be part of this launch while using this opportunity to appeal to the good people of this State, especially our Politicians to assist the University in its bid to put all these physical structures in place.

I want to assure the public that funds generated will be judiciously and efficiently managed for the continued development of the University.
